Dear Resident or Visitor to the City of Fredericksburg:

The City of Fredericksburg has implemented new technology called *autoChalk* to encourage our residents and visitors to obey the time-zone parking restrictions in the downtown district. **This is a warning notice only.**

Our records indicate that your vehicle was parked in a time restricted space (see attached Photo Series 1). The same vehicle was found to have remained at the same location without moving from the parking space, in excess of the allowable time limit (see attached Photo Series 2) and in violation of City Code Section 58-163 [c] which states in part *“Such vehicle must be removed from such parking space for a time period equal to the time period indicated on such sign.”*

In order to avoid further infractions and to fully enjoy the amenities offered by the City of Fredericksburg, there are several parking options available that are safe and convenient to the downtown historic district. There is a free municipal parking lot located in the 900 block of Sophia Street that is within walking distance to the shops and attractions downtown. The City also owns a 297-space parking garage at the intersection of Sophia Street and Wolfe Street. The Sophia Street Garage is open 24-hours a day, 7 days a week. It offers covered parking in a clean and well-lighted environment. A parking attendant is present to assist patrons during the day. Please note that parking in the garage is FREE for the first three hours of use, and just \$1.00 per hour for additional time.

Downtown Parking: Paid Parking Garage & Free Parking Lots

LEGEND_

1. Paid Parking Garage:
Intersection of Sophia Street and Wolfe Street (entrance on Wolfe Street).
2. Free Parking Lot:
400 block Sophia Street, just south of RR tracks, restricted to city residents between 5AM - 6PM.
3. Free Parking Lot:
Intersection of Sophia Street and Charlotte Street, next to Wings on the Water, 2 hour parking spaces Monday - Saturday between 9AM - 5PM.
4. Free Parking Lot:
700 block Sophia Street, between Charlotte Street and Hanover Street, restricted to city residents Monday - Friday between 5AM - 8AM.
5. Free Parking Lot:
800 - 900 blocks Sophia Street, end of George Street, restricted to city residents Monday - Friday between 5AM - 8AM.
6. Free Parking Lot:
1000 block Sophia Street, next to Barefoot Green's, no restrictions.
