**SUBJECT:** FY21 Asphalt Rehabilitation Program

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**ISSUE**

Shall the City Council authorize the City Manager to execute the construction contract for the FY21 Asphalt Rehabilitation Program?

**RECOMMENDATION**

Yes. We recommend that the City Council adopt the attached resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute a contract for the FY21 Asphalt Rehabilitation Program with Fredericksburg Asphalt and Paving of Ruther Glen, Virginia in the amount of \$ 577,154.82.

**DISCUSSION**

On July 1, 2021, the City received the following bids for the FY21 Asphalt Rehabilitation Program:

Fredericksburg Asphalt & Paving Inc	\$577,154.82
Espina Paving, Inc.	\$752,561.50
Virginia Paving Company	\$810,884.15

The Fredericksburg Asphalt bid is well below the available funds for streets designated to be covered by City of Fredericksburg.

Authorization to proceed is requested from City Council, based upon the low bid.

Award of this contract will permit the rehabilitation or reconstruction of the streets shown above. The inclusion of any alternative projects will only be accepted as program funds are available and only after completion of the original list of streets.

This work represents the normal work program for FY 2021 – City Council will be asked to carry forward the funding for the FY 2021 program into FY 2022 to complete this work. The FY 2022 paving program will proceed later this fiscal year.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT**

As discussed above, there are sufficient City funds (approximately \$695,000) remaining in FY 2021 available to perform the FY21 asphalt rehabilitation program.
