**July 13, 2021**

**The Council** of the City of Fredericksburg, Virginia, held a public hearing on Tuesday, July 13, 2021, beginning at 8:49 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall.

**Notice of Public Hearings (D21-\_\_ thru D21-\_\_).** The Clerk read the notice of the public hearings as they appeared in the local newspaper, the purpose being to solicit citizen input.

**Resolution 21-56, First Read, Amending the Fiscal Year 2021 School Budget to Appropriate Additional School Grants (D21-\_\_).** No speakers.

After staff presentation, Council Duffy disclosed that he was the Principal at James Monroe High School but he could participate fairly, objectively and in the public interest.

Councilor Frye disclosed that his was an employee of the Fredericksburg Public Schools but he could participate fairly, objectively and in the public interest.

Councilor Devine made a motion to approve Resolution 21-56, on first read, amending the Fiscal Year 2021 School Budget to appropriate additional school grants; motion was seconded by Councilor Withers and passed by the following recorded votes.
