The Arts Commission has had a few members come off the commission, this has left two organization vacancies and one at large vacancy. The term of Collette Caprara expired. Mr. Jay Downey moved out of state and Ms. Carole Garmon resigned, both of their terms end June 30, 2022. I would suggest whomever is selected to complete those terms continue through their first term without having to return for reappointment.

I currently have five applications, three could be considered for the organization openings: Joy Thomas, Julie Ellis and Steven Hu. They could also be considered to fill the at-large vacancy but we have two applicants, Jamie Roberson and John McGuire, III that can only be considered as at-large applicants because they are not a part of any organization that create art in the City.
