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**RECOMMENDATION**

Approve attached resolution extending the Planning Commission's review period for the draft Capital Impacts Study through July 31.

**BACKGROUND**

City Council adopted Resolution 22-16 at its regular meeting on March 8, 2022, initiating the formal review of the draft Capital Impacts Study. By adoption of this resolution, City Council referred the draft Capital Impacts Study to the Fredericksburg Planning Commission for public hearing and recommendation within 90 days. The 90-day review period expired June 8, 2022.

The Planning Commission held a public hearing on the draft Capital Impacts Study on May 25, 2022. The Planning Commission's review period was extended to allow deliberation at its June 22, 2022 meeting. Due to severe weather and power outage, the June 22 meeting was unable to be held. The next Planning Commission meeting will occur on July 13, 2022. The Planning Commission has requested an additional extension of time to permit it to complete its deliberations at that meeting.
