1. Call to Order

2. Topics for Committee Discussion

- Main Street Survey: 15-Minute Parking Signage Downtown
 - The committee voted that the last spot on the right be kept, and all other 15 minute spot locations are removed. At this time there would be one fifteen minute sign per block where they are currently established. Typically the furthest spot on the end.
 - Action: J. Jackson will confirm the list and get with public works on removal.

3. Staff Updates

- Dameron Court – Update provided on the status and feedback to the residents of Dameron Court on the “No-Parking Sign” removal. Due to requirements, related to emergency services access signage is unable to be removed. Staff are evaluating other options for the street; however, due to the geometry of the area and the code, those locations are limited.

a. Parking Deck Safety Enhancements

- City Management has received feedback from staff on Parking Deck Safety enhancements. Staff will work with be identifying a list of recommendations from Public Works and Parking Deck specific staff on options for enhancements and costs and related budgetary cost of implementation.

b. Residential Parking Permit Update

- Staff continues to work on feasibility of parking permit update within the City code. Including research to other localities. There are some unique challenges since other jurisdictions have their own unique code requirements and language.
