 - 15 people involved over 2 week period
 - 2 trimmings over two periods
 - Stewards are assigned area as liaison
 - Will only be doing light trimming (for Suckers and Face Slappers)
 - Tree Fredericksburg received grant and going to coordinate with Ann
 - FY18 Tree planting
 - o 50 trees scheduled
 - list comes from prior year lists and other professional observers
 - Areas of greatest need are identified
 - o Follow's Director Faucet's guidance
 - Attempt to be as transparent as possible
 - Voting on list takes a few iterations
 - \$85,000 in budget for tree care
 - July or Aug city manager publishes planting list and then goes for public comment
 - Fall planting slated for Oct 17, 2017
 - Spring planting 2017 is one day on Hanover

 - 25 on Franklin
 - 25 near Willis street near National park
- National park not ready for trees at this time but will look at it in the future

 - Low-Income solar MOU to be signed between Habitat for Humanity and GRID

 - Proposed solar equipment tax exemption/credit in City budget package
