Committee Updates

Clean Committee - Damien Cobey

- The school recycling program is gearing up. Some inside recycling containers have been delivered to Hugh Mercer Elementary. Education on recycling is crucial. Will need to consider how to measure success.
- The Radio Show on clean and green activities in the city on 11/01/18 was a success.
The city clean-up on 11/03/18 collected a large amount of trash from public spaces. Weight of collection is to be determined.

Green Committee - Frank Widic

- A total of 384 trees were planted this fall.
- 280 trees were given to the public this fall.
- A ribbon cutting for the Healing Grove in Memorial Park was held.
- New landscaping at the Fredericksburg Museum was completed.

Sustainability Committee- Robert Courtnage

- Working with the owners of the minor league nationals to incorporate Commercial Property Assessed Clean Energy (C-PACE) financing and environmental sustainability (energy efficiency, solar energy, water collection) in the new Fredericksburg stadium.
- The next steps for composting are being considered. A survey to determine community interest is being developed.
- The solar project at Thurman Brisben Center is continuing to evolve.
