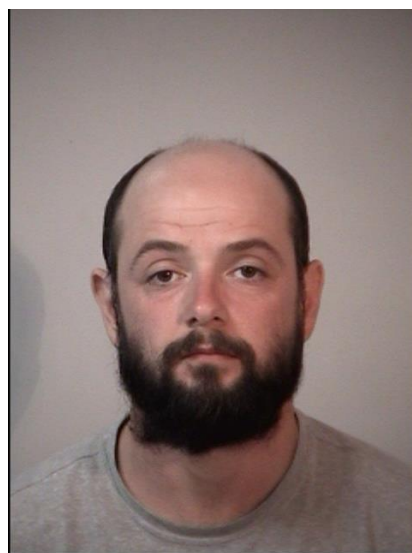

Police Arrest Suspect for Recent Burglary and Motor Vehicle Theft

The Fredericksburg Police Department arrested Eric Pezely for breaking and entering a car dealership and stealing a vehicle.

On November 15th, an employee of Fredericksburg Auto Finance arrived at work and discovered the front door glass was shattered. Video surveillance showed an unknown white male forced entry into the business at approximately 2:50 a.m. and stole multiple items, including a camera and money order. He also stole a 2003 Mercury Sable from the lot and drove off in an unknown direction.

After a thorough investigation by Detective G. Mejia, the suspect was identified as Eric James Pezely, 33, of no fixed address. On December 3rd, Pezely was arrested on felony charges of burglary with intent to commit larceny and grand larceny. He is currently being held and Rappahannock Regional Jail.
