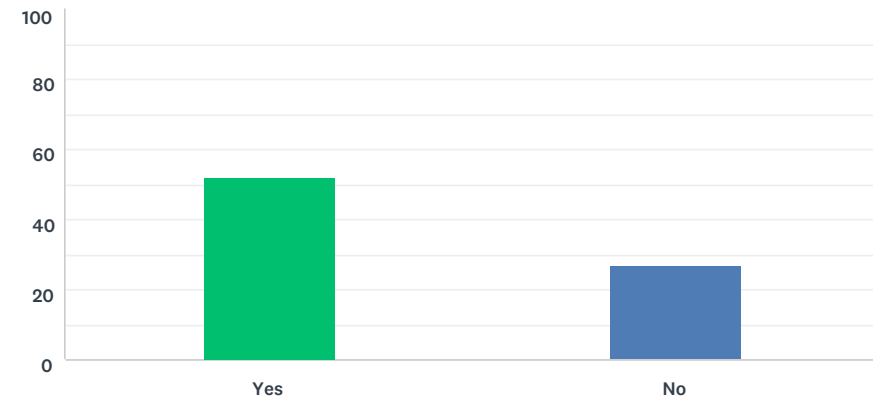


Q1 Do you live in the 22401 zip code?

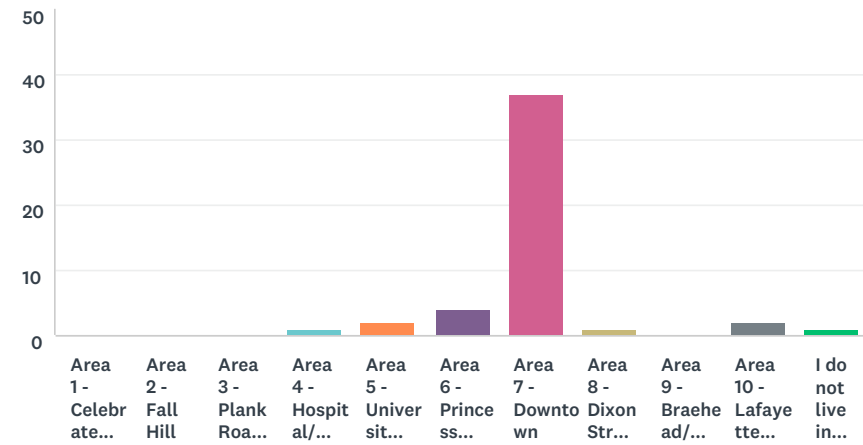

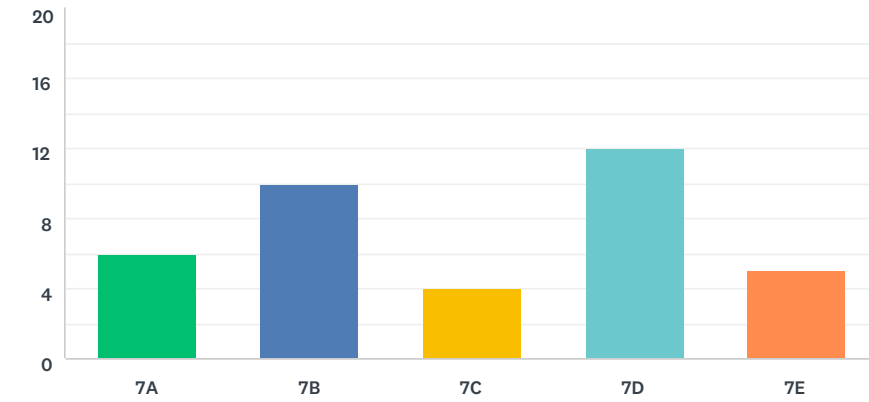

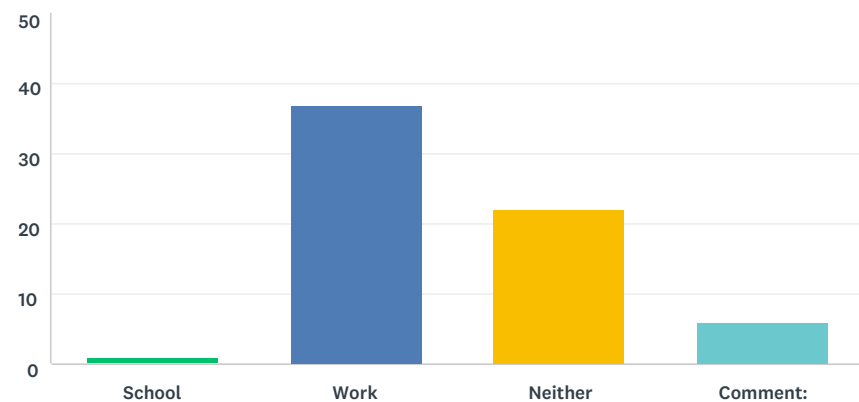

Q4 Do you work or go to school within the City?

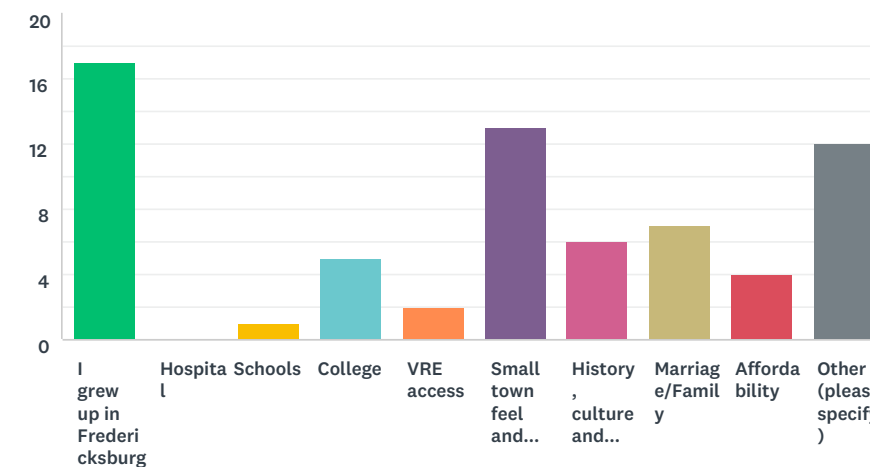
