Fredericksburg Police Arrest Homicide Suspect

After a thorough investigation led by Detective Wright, the Fredericksburg Police Department identified and arrested the suspect in last month's homicide and aggravated assault.

Jordan Reed, 20, of King George was arrested on felony charges of second-degree murder and aggravated malicious wounding as well as two felony charges of use of a firearm in commission of a felony. Reed is incarcerated without bond at the Rappahannock Regional Jail.

On September 16th at approximately 10:45 p.m., patrol officers responded to the 2500 block of Carriage Lane and located two victims with bullet wounds. Patrol officers set up a perimeter around the scene and began their investigation while a detective was requested to respond to the incident. EMS transported both victims to a nearby hospital where one was pronounced deceased. The other victim was hospitalized for non-life-threatening injuries.



The deceased victim is Connall Mullins, 18, of King George County.
