Mayfield Community Update - June 2021

CSX has continued to engage with community stakeholders and discuss activities in Fredericksburg with City officials and we wanted to offer several points of community interest.

Community Engagement

- Meeting with Fredericksburg Branch of NAACP Leadership - CSX met with the leadership team of the Fredericksburg NAACP to discuss their concerns with operations in the Fredericksburg Yard. We sincerely respect Branch President Charlyne Jackson-Fields and her team's leadership in the community and willingness to have a dialogue with CSX.

Community Improvement Support

- Community Improvement Support - In the past, CSX has supported community improvement projects in Mayfield such as the tree plantings along Railroad Ave. As a part of being a good neighbor, CSX has offered to partner with the City to support potential improvement or beautification projects to enhance the Mayfield community. We want to continue to look for opportunities to work together with stakeholders and be a positive influence in the community.

Supporting Local Businesses

While focus has been on our propane customer, CSX also provides safe, efficient and affordable rail service through the Fredericksburg Yard to numerous businesses in Fredericksburg and the surrounding area. These companies manufacture and distribute brick, steel and metal, lumber and wood products, building materials and services among other items to residential and commercial customers in Fredericksburg and across the country.

On average one rail car holds the equivalent of four truck loads. In addition to supporting Fredericksburg companies and their employees, CSX's local rail service through the Fredericksburg Yard removes hundreds of heavy tractor trailers trucks from roads in the community.

Trespassing Update

- Trespassing Reports - In previous updates, CSX has encouraged the community to contact the CSX Police Department at 800-232-0144 to report trespassing or suspicious activity around CSX's tracks. Since our first community update in April, we have received seven reports of trespassing in Fredericksburg. A majority of the instances are related to activity around the Fredericksburg Station. We appreciate the community's continued attention to these issues as we move into the summer and increased outdoor activity.
