



Leaf collection will start its 1<sup>st</sup> round on Monday, November 13, 2023.

The week of November 13-November 17 will include sections 1 through 5, weather permitting.

**Leaves must be at the curb/utility strip/edge of pavement.  
Vacuum will not go into yard past right of way.**

SECTION ONE:	Fitzhugh Street to William Street Sunken Road to Kenmore Avenue
SECTION TWO:	William Street to Lafayette Boulevard Sunken Road to Kenmore Avenue
SECTION THREE:	Lafayette Boulevard to William Street Kenmore Avenue to Sophia Street
SECTION FOUR:	William Street to Canal Street Washington Avenue to Sophia Street
SECTION FIVE:	Canal Street to the Rt. 1 Bypass Washington Avenue to Caroline Street

**PLEASE BE ADVISED**

If vacuum crew finishes early in the sections advertised for this time period, they may advance to collect leaf piles in sections not “officially” on the schedule; however, at the beginning of each week, they will still start working in the specified sections advertised for that week.



**New Leaf Truck makes for faster leaf collection.** The City put its new leaf collection truck into regular operation for 2022 Leaf Collection Season. The vehicle is a one-man operation vehicle. A driver is able to move from one pile of leaves to another, vacuum up the leaves without leaving the cab of the vehicle, and move on to the next pile. Typically, multi-man crews and trucks with vacuum machines are utilized for this operation. **The new vehicle will assist the Public Works Department in being more efficient by allowing faster passes through neighborhoods, resulting in a shorter leaf collection season.**
